The Board of Trustees met at 5:15 p.m., on July 12, 2022, for a public hearing regarding the Erie Business District. Roll call found the following Trustees present:

Jared, from Moran Economic Development, explained the Business District and its purpose to those present. It will be a 1% sales tax increase in the Village excluding food purchased for preparation at home, prescriptions or medical related items, and state licenses.

The following information is from the Village's Business District Redevelopment Plan:

The Village intends to utilize these funds in accordance to their Redevelopment Plan to make investments in the main commercial corridor in the Village through repairs and rehabilitation of the existing improvements and construction of new improvements with the hope of increasing sales and property tax revenues generated in the area for the village as well as provide a revenue source for the Village's economic development efforts.

Questions from the public were answered.
